# **Another Great Year for Georgia Undergraduate Applicants!**

Thanks to all our awesome interviewers for their work with the Class of 2017. We had a total of 670 applicants from Georgia (excluding Coastal GA). 39 students were admitted for an admit rate of 5.8%, which is exactly consistent with Harvard's overall admit rate of 5.8%. 24 of these students have chosen to attend Harvard, which gives us a yield of 62%.

Our Schools & Scholarships Committee is always looking for new interviewers both to interview candidates and to represent Harvard at college fairs. It's a great opportunity to stay connected with Harvard and to meet some of the promising young people from Georgia. Interviewers can be graduates of any degree program that required residence in Cambridge for at least one academic year.
