From the desk of the President

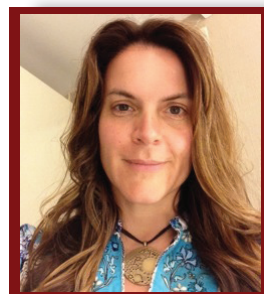

Details on how to become a member are included with this letter, including options ranging from recent grads to summa patrons.

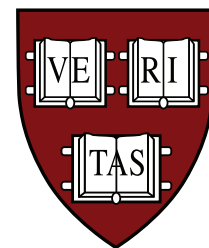
I look forward very much to your responses, to seeing our membership and participation grow, and to working together with you to make the 2014-2015 year truly exceptional in Club history

SCHOOLS & SCHOLARSHIPS *Interviewing and College Fairs*

Once again, we'd like to thank our hardworking Schools & Scholarships team for visiting multiple college fairs and for interviewing our 692 applicants from Georgia this year (excluding Coastal GA). We had 44 students admitted, for a total admit rate of 6.4%, slightly ahead of the 5.9% admit rate for the overall admissions pool.

If you would like to interview or represent Harvard at college fairs, we would love to have you get involved. Requirements for interviewers are as follows:

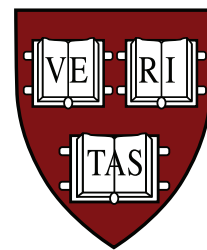
- You must be a graduate of a Harvard or Radcliffe degree program that required residence in Cambridge for at least one academic year.
- You may not have a child, sibling or other close relative applying to Harvard for the Class of 2019.
- You cannot be interviewing for any other undergraduate college (for example, you cannot interview for both Harvard and Princeton at the same time).
